Dear residents,

Every National Day is a heartening affair as Singaporeans rally to celebrate our nation's birthday. This year's NDP theme is #OneNationTogether, and like the theme suggests, we must stand together and support one another in good times as well as in times of uncertainty and challenges. I would also like to take this opportunity to wish all residents a Happy 52nd National Day!

On another note, many of you would have seen or even used bicycles from bike-sharing services. Bike-sharing schemes complement public transport by offering the bicycle as a convenient, environment-friendly and affordable option to complete the first or last leg of a journey. Unfortunately, some bike users have not taken care to park their bicycles properly at the appropriate places – the Land Transport Authority (LTA) has issued about 1,000 notices this year for indiscriminately-parked bicycles.

Ang Mo Kio Town Council is working with LTA to increase the bicycle-parking capacity in the neighbourhood. To date, we have added 42 bicycle-parking zones, marked out by yellow boxes, at some areas with high human traffic, such as near markets, parks and bus stops. We hope bike users can do their part and park the bicycles within these designated parking areas so that they do not cause obstruction or inconvenience to residents. Happy riding!

Do you know what makes Ang Mo Kio Town Council run smoothly? Well, it consists of five committees and each one oversees an area or project. And together, the five committees – Business Liaison Committee, Publicity & Outreach Committee, Finance Management Committee, Estate Maintenance Committee and Project Development Committee – ensure that the estate and residents are well taken care of.

Our Home gives you a closer look at these committees, and in this issue, the focus is on the Project Development Committee (PDC).

Building estates that change with you

Dr Intan Azura Mokhtar, chairperson of the PDC, tells us how the committee ensures the town physically evolves with residents' changing needs.



Q: What does the Project Development Committee do?

A: When residents request amenities and facilities for the estate, the committee will look into the requests and implement them if possible. It also takes charge of the long-term physical development of the town and recommends amenities and improvement works that are needed.



Q: What are the priorities of the PDC?

A: The PDC is focused on physically improving the estate to give residents a better living environment. This includes improving connectivity, maintaining safety and making things more convenient for everyone.

Q: How does the PDC ensure the town stays relevant to residents' changing needs?

A: The feedback that residents give us is crucial in helping us plan amenities for them. We welcome residents to give feedback by meeting their respective MPs as well as through the Town Council's various feedback channels.

Q: What large-scale projects has the PDC implemented this year?

A: The Neighbourhood Renewal Programmes held in various locations are some large-scale projects implemented this year. These include the construction of gardens and parks, hard courts for activities, marquees for functions and indoor playgrounds.

Q: What can residents look forward to in the future?

A: In the future, there will be more indoor playgrounds under housing blocks, elderly fitness and general exercise stations at void decks, covered pavilions, sheltered marquees and gardening spaces.



Nursing home for graceful ageing

Ren Ci @ Ang Mo Kio, a nursing home that will give its residents an intimate, home-like environment, has opened.

Under its “household cluster living” concept, 16 residents in four bedrooms will form a household cluster and share a common living, dining and activity area. This will give the residents a greater level of privacy, dignity and autonomy.

The 11-storey nursing home with 472 beds opened after nearly two years of construction. It is part of the Ministry of Health’s plan to build a robust home and community care ecosystem to support our seniors with ageing in place. It also aims to bring integrated aged care services closer to the community.

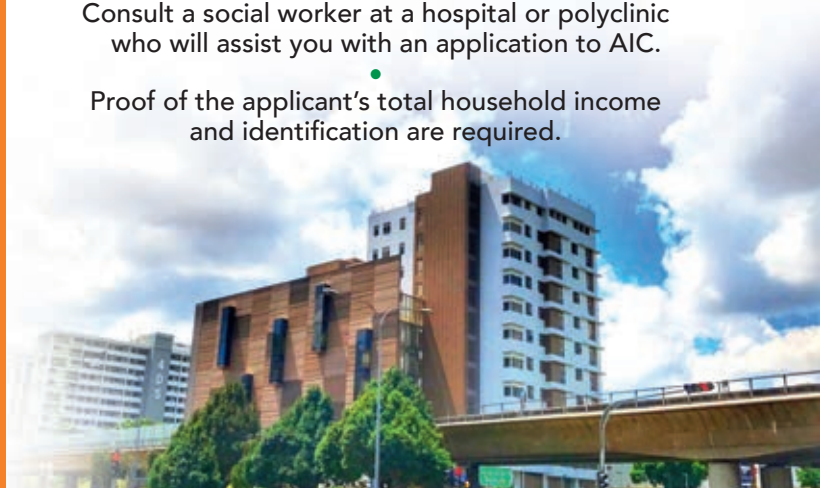


HOW TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION:

Proof of the applicant’s total household income and identification are required.

TeamSG waterskier and SEA Games gold medallist Mark Leong gives us the lowdown on his memories growing up in Ang Mo Kio, how he celebrates National Day and what he hopes to achieve at the SEA Games.

Q: What do you hope to achieve at the upcoming SEA Games?

A: My aim is to defend my title and improve my score from the previous SEA Games. I want to be on the 11m line, which I don't think anyone has done at the SEA Games. I've done it before in other competitions and I hope to bring my performance up to that level.

Q: How have you been prepping yourself to hit your goal?

A: I'm sticking to a training schedule and making sure I get enough sleep at night. Sleep is important because without it, I wouldn't have the energy to have a good training session after a long day at school. I also eat well, which helps.

Q: What does National Day mean to you?

A: It is a day to celebrate my patriotism for Singapore. I like seeing so many Singaporeans dressed in red and standing together to sing National Anthem.

Q: How have you been celebrating National Day?

A: For the past few years, when the celebrations were held at the Marina Bay Floating Platform, my family, friends and I would head to the area to watch the aerial displays and the fireworks. This year, I was training for the SEA Games.

Q: What are some fond childhood memories of growing up in Ang Mo Kio?

A: Almost every evening, I would be playing football, badminton, catching or even skate-scooting up and down the street with my neighbours. We'd always keep an eye out for approaching cars and yell "Car's coming!" to the other kids to warn them, and everyone would scurry to the sides of the road to wait for the car to pass before we continued. We'd play until our mothers came to call us for dinner.

It is the time of the year again when our neighbourhood is awash with a sea of Singapore flags and bannerettes celebrating the joy of National Day.

This year, the bannerettes feature images of Ang Mo Kio residents along seven themes – children, adults, pioneer, students, cultural, sports and uniform. Cultural-themed bannerettes, for example, show the smiling faces of people of different races in traditional costumes beaming at passersby.

Ms Felicia Ong, 29, is one of the residents featured under the cultural category, dressed in a cheongsam. “I feel really honoured and proud to be featured on a National Day display,” she says.

The Residents’ Committees also got busy rallying volunteers to put up National Day displays in the estates and went door-to-door to hand out Singapore flags for residents to display outside their units.

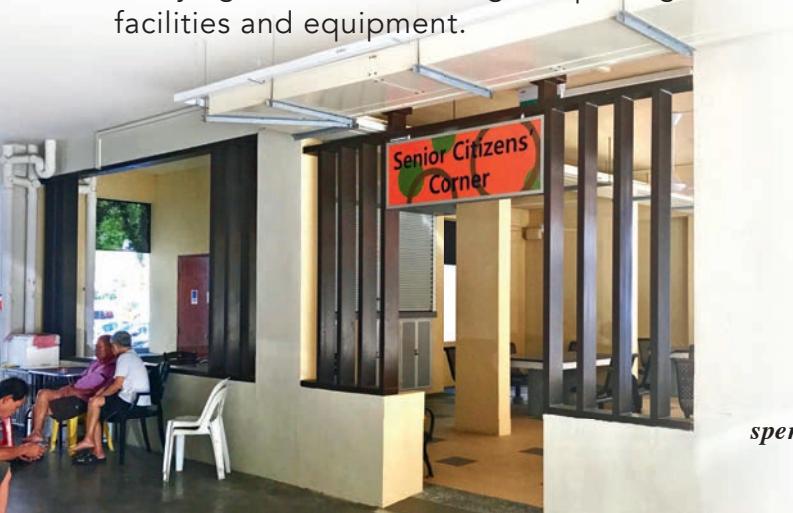

Facilities for seniors

To allow seniors to age gracefully, it is important to create a caring, empowering and safe environment. This is especially so given Singapore's ageing population. And in the estate, senior citizens' corners and elderly fitness corners have been upgraded with improvements such as laying down new flooring and putting in new facilities and equipment.

Branching out to other tree species

Trees toppling over and hitting passersby and vehicles have been in the headlines. Species like *Khaya senegalensis* (Senegal Mahogany) are particularly prone to falling because they can grow to heights of 30m and also break easily.

To make things safer for residents, the Town Council has embarked on a Khaya Tree Replacement Program. The Khaya trees will be replaced with other species which are safer.

How long will this take? This on-going programme will run for the next three years.

How does it work? Our horticulture team will identify Khaya trees in the estate and seek HDB's approval to remove them. After the Khaya trees have been removed, we replace them with trees of other species to maintain the greenery in the estate.

What is the progress? To date, we have identified about 100 Khaya trees in the neighbourhood. Those

planted on slopes, near HDB blocks and areas with high human traffic will be removed first because they are more at risk of causing danger.

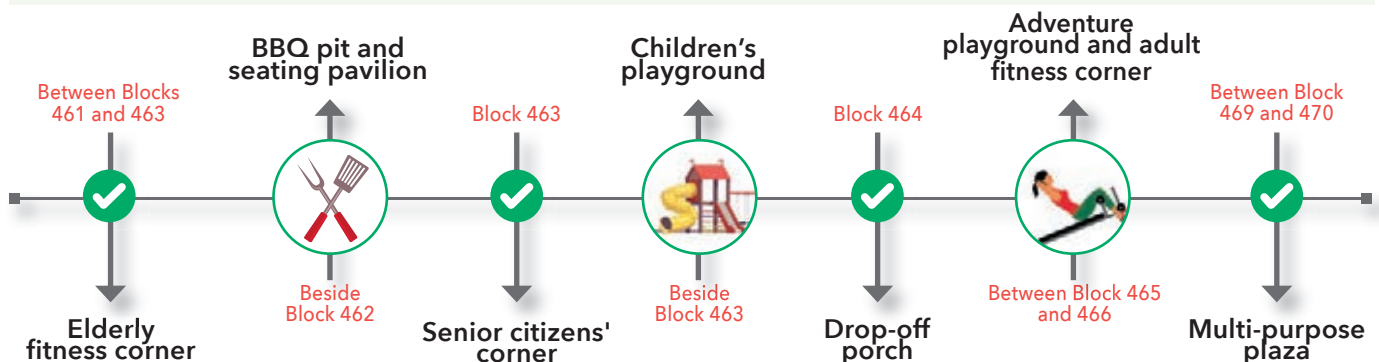

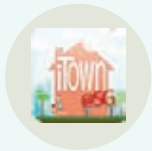
