Rat problem under control

Rats can be hard to get rid of – they are known for their adaptability and strong survival instincts, which helps them to multiply quickly in urban areas.

But Ang Mo Kio Town Council has seen results in its efforts to eradicate rats in the neighbourhood.


Under its rodent control programme, the town council team searches for rat burrows, treats them and culls rats. To prevent the rats from coming back, the town council also cleans bin compounds daily and conducts regular pest control checks.

Over the last two years, the number of rat burrows detected has decreased by more than 40 percent.

The town council team will continue its efforts to monitor rat activity and also educate residents about rodent infestations. It also seeks the support and cooperation of residents to tackle the problem together. Residents are encouraged to inform the town council of any rat sightings.

Maintaining trees for a greener future

Just like we humans need to take care of our bodies to keep ourselves in good health, the trees around Ang Mo Kio estate, too, need to get regular health checks, and see a "doctor" if they fall ill.

Ang Mo Kio Town Council's horticulture team, assisted by maintenance workers, are the people taking care of the 22,000 trees in Ang Mo Kio GRC and Sengkang West SMC. Under the team's maintenance programme, the trees are inspected regularly for disease. Trees fall ill sometimes because of stress from extreme temperatures, air pollution from construction work or pest infestations. Therefore, unhealthy parts of the trees are pruned away to keep the trees in top shape.

Some trees also pose a safety risk, such as those blocking the view of roads and road signs and interfering with telephone or power lines. These trees are also pruned for the safety of residents.

The horticulture team also monitors the watering and fertilising of plants, and with their help, the estate has become a greener, more livable home.

MEMPAT TREE

Known as Singapore Sakura, the tree produces a spectacular mass of pink flowers.

TRUMPET TREE

As its name suggests, the bloom comprises a cluster of small trumpet-shaped flowers. It has a large, broadly conical and shady crown.



Serving with heart

Interruptions to your home's power supply can be frustrating. But when you have bags of breast milk stored in your freezer, it can be downright anxiety-causing.

So when Ms Ng Boon Min, a mother with a newborn living in Teck Ghee division, found out about a scheduled power shutdown to her block on 10 April 2018 from 1pm to 3pm, she immediately contacted Ang Mo Kio Town Council about her concerns. She was worried that the two-hour power shutdown would cause her stored breast milk go bad.

The power shutdown was part of routine works to check electrical connections for loose or

damaged wires, which can cause fire outbreaks or other issues.

While the power shutdown was necessary, property officer Dwayne Ong, 27, understood Ms Ng's concerns. So he and his colleague, Mr Damon Toh, spoke to the contractor conducting the safety checks and worked out a plan which reduced the power cuts to Ms Ng's unit to just 30 mins, down from the originally scheduled two hours.

"My colleague helped with the communications and our contractor put in effort to ensure the operations ran smoothly. It felt great that we were able to assist her," says Mr Ong, who joined the town council last year. His job is to attend to the common areas within and around the estate, including responding to residents' feedback and requests.

To commend Mr Ong for his efforts, the Town Council presented him with a Best Customer Service Award in May.

True or false: With so many cleaners in my estate, I can throw rubbish on the ground and they will pick up after me.

You may answer “false”, but you’ll be surprised at the number of people who have been caught littering in Singapore. In fact, last year, the National Environment Agency (NEA) handed out 32,000 fines for littering, which was an eight-year high.

Some people may have the mistaken idea that estate cleaners will clean up after them, but the cleaners can only do so much. Therefore, it’s important for all of us to not litter and to also pick up after ourselves.

It was this line of thought that sparked the theme of “I PHC (Pick up at Home & in Community). Do you?” for this year’s annual clean-up campaign run by the Public Hygiene Council.

In response to the month-long campaign, Ang Mo Kio GRC and Sengkang West SMC residents pitched in and helped pick up litter around their

homes in several clean-up sessions. And some of the residents start young – 10-year-old Tayden Tham was playing basketball on May 12 when he saw Sengkang West residents picking litter and volunteered to join in.

He believes that Singapore can be litter-free. He said: “I am doing my part to keep this area of Singapore clean, and I will encourage my friends who live in other neighbourhoods to do the same. With our effort, we can live in a clean city.”



捡起垃圾 从我开始


一起来看看以下的“是非题”：我住的组屋区有那么多清洁工人，我丢的垃圾，反正有他们会清理。

这种说法对吗？你可能会说“错”，但国家环境局提供的“垃圾虫”数据可能会让你吃惊。单单去年，国家环境局就发出了3万2000张乱扔垃圾的罚单，创下八年来新高。

有些人可能误以为，保持社区的清洁是清洁工人的责任，但单靠他们打理是不够的。重要的是每个人除了不乱抛垃圾以外，也要把垃圾捡起来丢掉。这也是公共卫生理事会为今年清洁运动设定的主题：“我捡了（家里和邻里的垃圾）。你呢？”所要传达的信息。

配合这项为期一个月的年度清洁运动，宏茂桥集选区和盛港西单选区举办了多场社区清洁活动。这些活动获得居民们的热烈响应和参与，就连稚龄儿童在看到其他人捡垃圾时，也会主动帮忙。例如5月12日在盛港西举行的社区清洁活动上，一名原本在打篮球的10岁小男孩泰登（音译）就不落后人后，当场加入正在捡垃圾的人群，为社区的清洁出力。

这个小男孩相信新加坡可以成为零垃圾国家。他说：“我为新加坡这个角落的清洁出一点力，也会鼓励住在其他邻里的朋友这么做。大家一起努力的话，我们就会有一个清洁的城市了。”

Young hearts, big effort

It was a hot, sunny afternoon on May 3 but that did not deter 35 volunteers from Mayflower Primary School from picking litter near their school. They were taking part in a collaborative community outreach programme between their school and Ang Mo Kio Town Council. Through this programme, the Town Council hopes to help the students develop a sense of belonging to the community as well as an appreciation for their home.

The Primary Three students, led by their teachers, combed the outdoor courtyard and fields between Block 641 and Block 643 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 4 for trash. They picked litter such as carton boxes, candles, discarded CDs and plastic straws.

Teacher Matthew Phua, 35, said: "This is the first time we are collaborating with the town council on such an activity. We taught a lesson on environmental cleanliness to the students before taking them out for this activity. We hope that after this,

the students will be more aware of how a clean environment can benefit everyone."

A similar litter-picking activity also took place on May 18. More than 80 Primary Five students from Da Qiao Primary School helped to pick up trash from Block 549 to Block 561 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 10.

"I enjoyed the activity as I like to help with cleaning at home. I will also pick up litter if I see any at the void deck," said student Siti Nor Umairah bte Muhammad.


